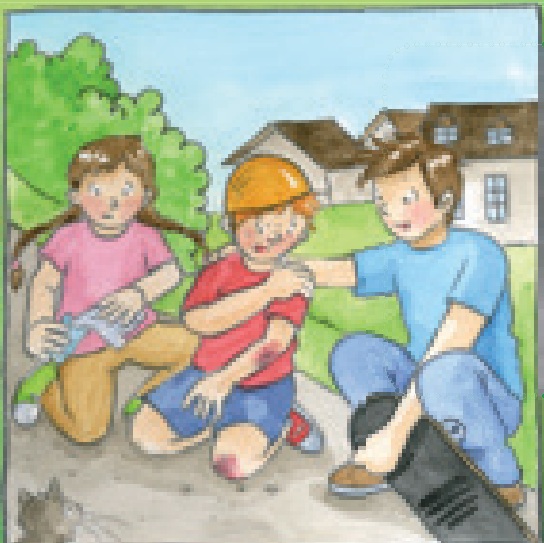

And my cheek, I fell on my face!

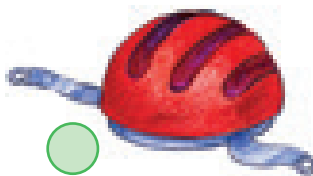
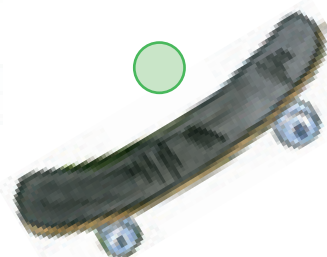
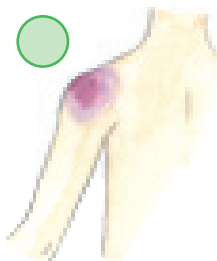
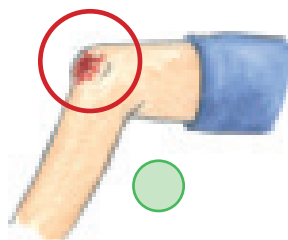
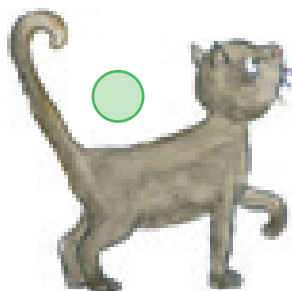
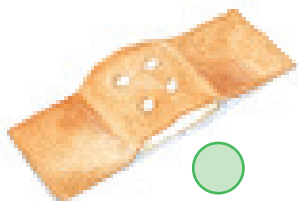

Do I / you / we / they **drink** water?

**Does** he / she / it **drink** water?

Attention! **Not:** Does he / she / it **drinks** water?

But:

**drink**

I / you / we / they **don't drink** water.

He / she / it **doesn't drink** water.

Attention! **Not:** He / she / it **doesn't drinks** water.

But:

**drink**
