



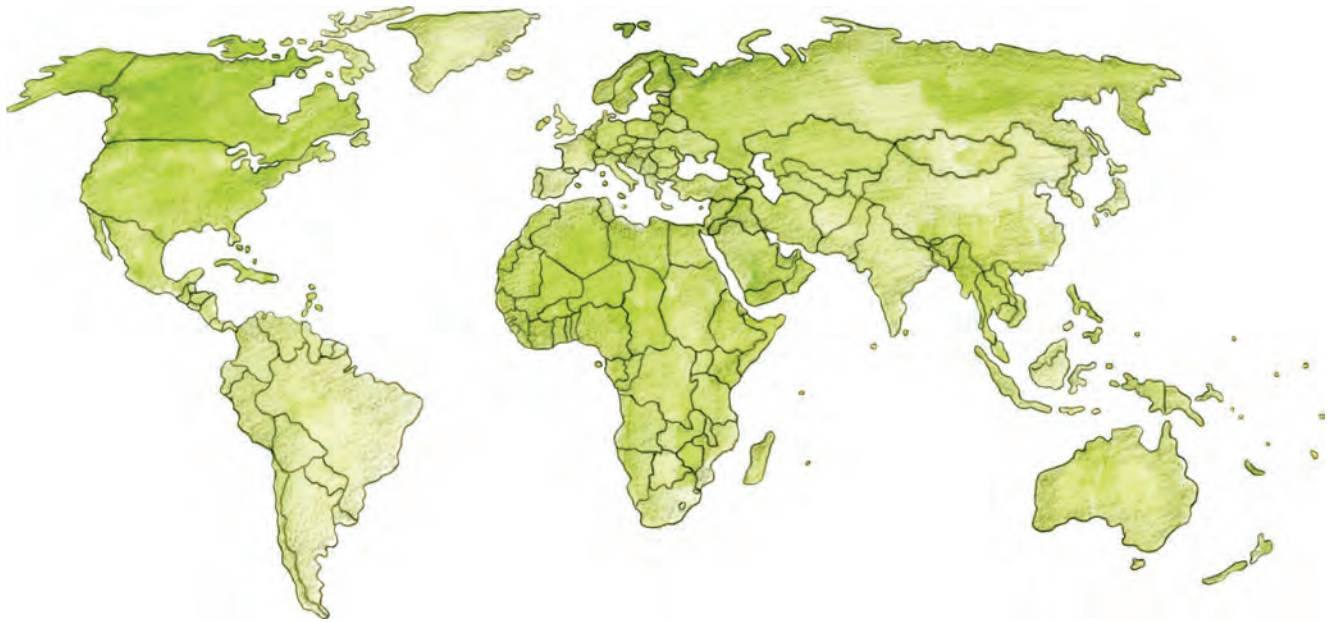

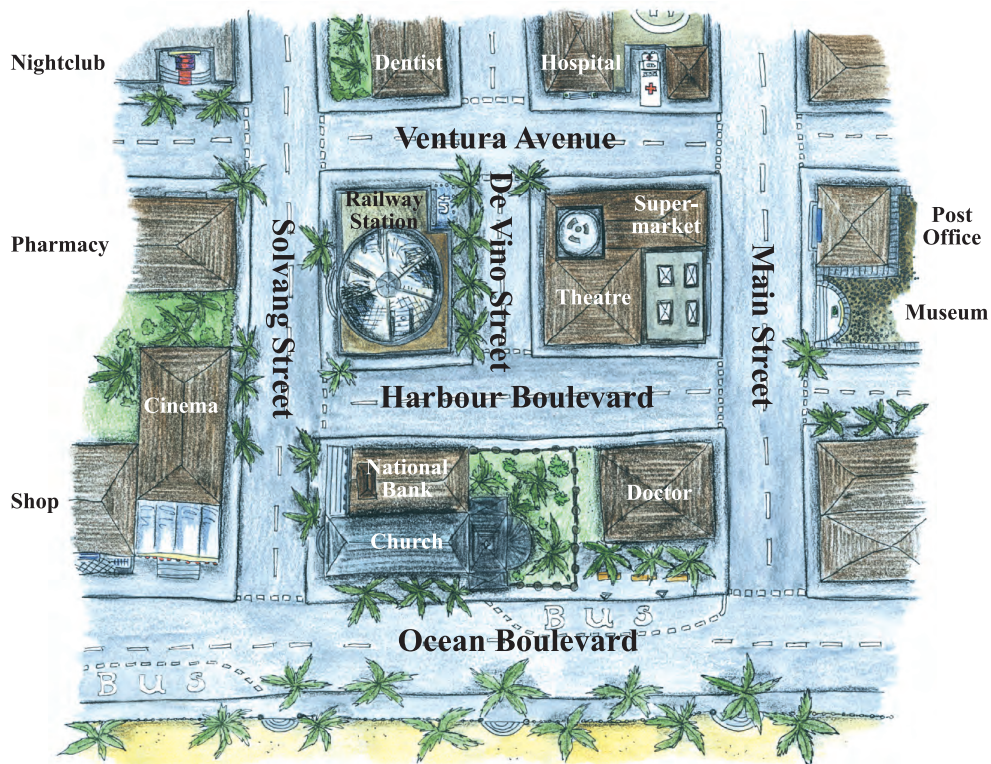
Klaus: So, it's first left, then right, then left?
